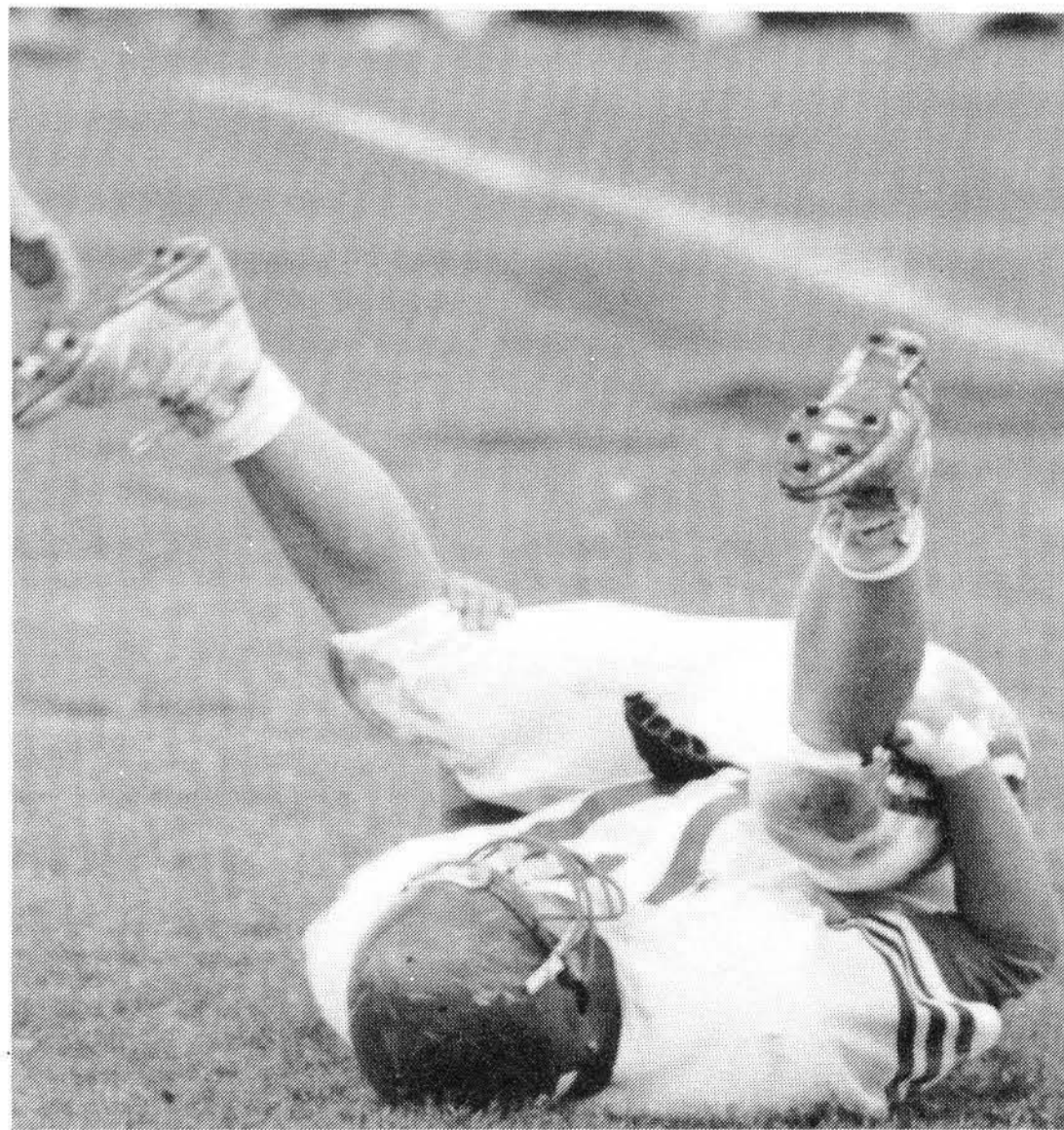
Many individual honors were achieved. Brian Clark set a new school career record for
